SUBJECT: APPLICATION FOR EXCLUSIVE USE OF CITY FACILITIES

DATE: APRIL 1, 2021

ISSUE

Shall the Recreation Commission grant the exclusive use permit for Mendota Youth Recreation for the use of the Benny Mares Baseball Field?

BACKGROUND

In early March, two organizations (Mendota Youth Recreation and Westside Youth Inc.) submitted facility use applications for the use of the Benny Mares Baseball field. Both applications requested the use of the field on conflicting days. At its March 23rd regular meeting, the City Council directed staff to bring forth the applications to the Recreation Commission at its next regular meeting so that the Commission can work with both organizations to establish a schedule that is acceptable to all.

Since then, Westside Youth Inc. contacted staff and requested to rescind their application. As such, the Commission will only be considering the application submitted by Mendota Youth Recreation (MYR) which is attached.

ANALYSIS

The application received from MYR requests the use of the Benny Mares Sr. Baseball Field for youth baseball. MYR is requesting to use the baseball field Tuesdays and Thursdays from 4p.m.-9 p.m. and on Saturday from 9a.m.-5p.m. They are not charging an entry fee and plan to use the concession stand and lights, when necessary.

In regard to the guidance provided by the California Department of Public Health relating to outdoor youth sports, baseball is considered an "Outdoor Moderate-Contact Sport" and is permitted when the county is in the red tier. Currently, Fresno County is in the purple tier and baseball is not permitted under the state's guidelines. When the sport is permitted, organizations must abide by the COVID-19 prevention requirements that are contained within the State's guidelines and as the local jurisdiction requires.


FISCAL IMPACT

As attached, the fees charged would only be those related to the concession stand use, which would be \$10 for every half day, to be paid before the organization starts use of the field. In addition, there will need to be an administrative security deposit paid by the organization (before its respective use of the field) of \$250, which is refundable once their use ceases and it is confirmed that the facilities are intact in their original state.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the Commission approve the use of the Benny Mares Sr. Baseball Field as requested in the attached application with the following conditions:

- 1. Mendota Youth Recreation utilize the baseball field on the days and times that have been outlined in the application and/or agreed to at the meeting; and
- 2. MYR provide the city with any updates to its schedule, including any changes that occur mid-season that cause the field to be un-used when it was previously declared it would be used; and
- 3. MYR inform City Hall in advance of the specific days and time they will be using the concession stand; and
- 4. MYR pay the necessary fees and/or deposits, based on their submitted schedules, before beginning use of the field, as well as providing proof of insurance and any other information the City Manager may request; and
- 5. MYR maintain the field based on their use and immediately report any observed problems, whether or not caused directly by their use, to the Director of Public Works or his designee; and
- 6. Any additional conditions that the Commission requires.
