## City of Mendota Baseball Field Banner Sponsorship Program Overview

#### PROGRAM SUMMARY

The Banner Sponsorship Program (the "Program") was established in 2021 by the Mendota City Council and Recreation Commission as a sponsorship opportunity for the City of Mendota ("City") Baseball Fields at Rojas-Pierce Park. Through the Program, individuals and agencies have the ability to sponsor the baseball field of their choice (depending on space availability) for the duration of the baseball season by purchasing a banner sponsorship package. The proceeds from the Program will be utilized for recreational purposes in the City.

#### APPLICATION PROCEDURE

To apply for a sponsorship package, those interested must complete the Banner Order Form and submit the fee to Mendota City Hall, located at 643 Quince Street, Mendota, CA 93640. The City will accept payment via cash, check, money order, or debit card (there is a \$3 additional fee for debit card payments).

Once the Banner Order Form has been received and the payment has been processed, the sponsor must submit their logo (if desired) via email to <a href="mailto:ccabrera@cityofmendota.com">ccabrera@cityofmendota.com</a>. The logo must be in high format and in either PDF or JPG format. The City will be design the banner and submit the artwork for the creation of the banner to the contracted banner company.

#### BANNER INSTALLATION AND DISPLAY

The banners will be installed at the sponsor's baseball field of choice (depending on space availability) in the location based upon the purchased sponsorship package (either the outfield fence if the Gold Package was purchased or the baseball line fence if the Silver Package was purchased). The banner will be displayed during the duration of the annual baseball season (February through November) and the banner will be given to the sponsor at the end of the season.
