PURSUANT TO THE BROWN ACT**

RESOLUTION NO. 22-09

WHEREAS, on March 4, 2020, Governor Newsom declared a State of Emergency due to the outbreak and spread of COVID-19 (Novel Coronavirus); and

WHEREAS, on March 15, 2020, the County of Fresno declared a State of Emergency in response to the continuing spread of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2020, the City Council of the City of Mendota ("City") adopted Resolution No. 20-18 proclaiming a local emergency in response to the continuing spread of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, all meetings of the City's legislative bodies are open and public as required by the Ralph M. Brown Act (Gov. Code, §§ 54950-54963), so that any member of the public may attend, participate, and watch the City's legislative bodies conduct their business; and

WHEREAS, Governor Newsom signed Assembly Bill 361 ("AB 361") into law on September 16, 2021, and AB 361 went into effect immediately pursuant to an emergency clause; and

WHEREAS, AB 361 amended Government Code section 54953's requirements related to teleconference participation in meetings by members of the City's legislative bodies, subject to certain conditions, permitting members of the City's legislative body to participate remotely without complying with paragraph (3) of subdivision (b) of Government Code section 54953's requirements; and

WHEREAS, the City may use teleconferencing without complying with paragraph (3) of subdivision (b) of Government Code section 54953's requirements under any of the following circumstances: (1) the City's legislative body holds a meeting during a proclaimed state of emergency, and state or local officials have imposed or recommended measures to promote social distancing; (2) the City's legislative body holds a meeting during a proclaimed state of emergency for the purpose of determining,

by majority vote, whether as a result of the emergency, meeting in person would present imminent risks to the health or safety of attendees; or (3) the City's legislative body holds a meeting during a proclaimed state of emergency and has determined, by majority vote, that, as a result of the emergency, meeting in person would present imminent risks to the health or safety of attendees; and

WHEREAS, a proclamation of a state of emergency is declared by the Governor pursuant to Government Code section 8625, proclaiming the existence of conditions of disaster or extreme peril to the safety of persons and property within the state caused by conditions as described in Government Code 8558; and

WHEREAS, a proclamation is made when there is an actual incident, threat of disaster, or extreme peril to the safety of persons and property within the jurisdictions that are within the City's boundaries, caused by natural, technological, or human-caused disasters; and

WHEREAS, Mendota Municipal Code ("MMC") Section 2.44.020 defines "emergency" as the actual or threatened existence of conditions of disaster or of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property within this city caused by such conditions as air pollution, fire, flood, storm, epidemic, riot or earthquake, or other conditions, including conditions resulting from a labor controversy, which conditions are or are likely to be beyond the control of the services, personnel, equipment and facilities of this city requiring the combined forces of other political subdivisions to combat; and

WHEREAS, MMC section 2.44.060 and Government Code section 8630 empower the City Council, if in session, to proclaim the existence of a local emergency when the City is threatened by the existence of conditions of disaster or of extreme peril; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Governor's March 4, 2020, Proclamation of a State of Emergency, and the City's March 16, 2020, Proclamation of a Local Emergency, such emergency conditions persist in the City; and

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic emergency remains a significant challenge worldwide and throughout the United States according to the Centers for Disease Control; and

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic emergency remains a significant challenge throughout California according to the California Department of Public Health; and

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic emergency remains a significant challenge throughout the City in accordance with the State of California's current health and safety guidelines and the City's duty to provide and maintain a safe community for its citizens and a workplace free of known hazards, constituting a local emergency; and

WHEREAS, following the December 2021 holidays, COVID-19 positivity rates and new positive COVID-19 cases per day have surged, consistently trending upward each week since December 27, 2021; and

WHEREAS, on January 25, 2022, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 22-06, proclaiming a continued local emergency, ratifying the proclamation of a State of Emergency by the Governor on March 4, 2020, and authorizing remote teleconference meetings of the City's legislative bodies for a period of thirty days pursuant to the Brown Act; and

WHEREAS, the recent surges in COVID-19 cases is a continued cause for concern within the City, and demands the City continue promoting further social distancing among its citizens in an effort to curtail COVID-19 infection and hospitalization rates; and

WHEREAS, Governor Newsom's March 4, 2020, proclamation of a State of Emergency throughout California remains in effect despite State and Local orders being expected to trend toward relaxing COVID-19-related response measures in the future; and

WHEREAS, to date, many masking, social distancing, and vaccination requirements and recommendations remain in effect throughout the State to prevent a resurgence of COVID-19 infections; and

WHEREAS, as a consequence of the ongoing local emergency, and as authorized by subdivision (e) of Government Code section 54953, the City Council finds that the City's legislative bodies should continue conducting their public meetings without compliance with paragraph (3) of subdivision (b) of Government Code section 54953 to avoid the imminent risks to attendees' health and safety that accompany in-person participation, and that such legislative bodies shall comply with all necessary requirements to provide the public with access to public meetings as described in paragraph (2) of subdivision (e) of Government Code section 54953.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Mendota that:

Section 1. Recitals. The Recitals set forth above are true and correct and are incorporated into this Resolution by this reference as though fully set forth herein.

Section 2. Proclamation of Local Emergency. In accordance with the current State of California health and safety guidelines and the City of Mendota's duty to provide an maintain a safe community for its citizens, the City Council of the City of Mendota hereby proclaims the local emergency it proclaimed on March 16, 2020, related to the COVID-19 pandemic emergency, is ongoing.

Section 3. Ratification of Governor Newsom’s Proclamation of a State of Emergency. The City Council of the City of Mendota hereby ratifies Governor Newsom’s March 4, 2020, Proclamation of a State of Emergency throughout California.

Section 4. Remote Teleconference Meetings. The City of Mendota’s legislative bodies are hereby authorized and directed to take all actions necessary to carry out the intent and purpose of this Resolution to conduct open and public meetings using teleconferencing in accordance with subdivision (e) of Government Code section 54953 and the other applicable provisions of the Brown Act.

Section 5. Effective Date of Resolution. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption and shall be effective until the earlier of March 24, 2022, or such time the City Council adopts a subsequent Resolution in accordance with paragraph (3) of subdivision (e) of Government Code section 54953 to extend the time during which the City of Mendota’s legislative bodies may continue to teleconference without compliance with paragraph (3) of subdivision (b) of Government Code section 54953.

ISSUE

Shall the City Council adopt Resolution No. 22-10, approving the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 State Local Fiscal Recovery Funds Subrecipient Certifications and Commitment of Responsibility?

BACKGROUND

On March 11, 2021, the American Rescue Plan of 2021 (ARPA) was signed into law by President Biden, with the goal of accelerating the national recovery from the COVID-19 pandemic. On May 10, 2021, the United States Department of the Treasury (Treasury) issued the Interim Final Rule (IFR) to guide recipients and facilitate rapid and effective implementation of the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF) program established under ARPA. The County of Fresno (County) is a recipient of SLFRF under ARPA. The County may, but is not required to, award SLFRF to entities, whom the County determines as eligible, and referred to herein as eligible subrecipients, to conduct a program on behalf of the County, which will be subrecipients under ARPA.

The County will receive \$194,063,657 of SLFRF in two installments. The County received the first tranche of \$97,031,825 on June 17, 2021 and will receive the remaining balance in May of 2022.

On February 1, 2022, the County Board of Supervisors (County Board) “earmarked” approximately \$37.3 million of its SLFRF that might be allocated for eligible subrecipient programs and projects. Such earmarking is only a preliminary indication of allocation of SLFRF, and is subject to change or elimination, and in any event, does not obligate the County to award any SLFRF to any prospective subrecipients, or in any amount, so earmarked.

Based on the County Board’s determination, SLFRF may be used for eligible activities under four general categories:

1. Supporting public health response/addressing negative economic impacts;
2. Providing premium pay for essential workers;
3. Replacing public sector revenue loss, subject to certain limitations; and
4. Investment in water and sewer infrastructure, and broadband infrastructure.

Subject to the County Board's determination, SLFRF may only be used to cover costs for eligible activities within those four general categories for the period that begins March 3, 2021 and ends on December 31, 2024. All funds not obligated by December 31, 2024 and any funds not expended to cover such obligations by December 31, 2026 must be returned to the Treasury.

ANALYSIS

On February 8, 2022, the City Council voted on moving forward with a Police Department and Council Chambers Project. The estimated cost of this project is \$7 million. The City of Mendota (City) currently has \$2,958,403.19 in the coffers for this project. The City has received an installment from SLFRF funds and will be receiving a second installment or tranche this coming May. This is the same funding source that the County is administering their subrecipient program or project.

The next tranche that the City will be receiving, will allow to pledge \$2,013,203.51 towards the Police Department and Council Chambers Project. This will bring a total of \$4,971,606.70. The City will still have a deficit of \$2,028,393.30 for the Police Department and Council Chambers Project. With the County's subrecipient program or project, the City will be submitting an application requesting the \$2,028,393.30 in order to build the Police Department and Council Chambers Project.

The application for the County's subrecipient program or project requires an authorized representative of the organization to submit on behalf of the organization.

FISCAL IMPACT

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt Resolution No. 22-10, approving the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 State Local Fiscal Recovery Funds Subrecipient Certifications and Commitment of Responsibility.

Capital Outlay Projects may include construction or improvement of critical facilities such as public safety. Service Projects may include service to support other underserved populations.

There is no guarantee that funding will be allocated. If there is an award, the entity must enter into a grant agreement with California Natural Resources Agency (CNRA). The budget oversight will be handled by the Bonds and Grants United with CNRA. All budget request proposals and supporting documents are due on Friday, February 25, 2022 at the close of the business to Anna Velazquez via email.

ANALYSIS

Since the City of Mendota (City) reinstated the Mendota Police Department (MPD) in 2009, the City has been seeking a permanent home. In the past couple of years, the City has been gaining traction on making this dream a reality. We have received two generous installments for public safety from our Senators, former Senator Anthony Cannella and our current Senator, Anna Caballero, and purchased real property in Downtown Mendota. However, our public safety funding is not nearly enough to construct a new police station. The City will be submitting a budget proposal to our Senator Anna Caballero to finalize our project funding to build a new police department and council chambers. The Council Chambers will feature up-to-date building standards to accommodate Americans with Disabilities and serve as Senior Center for our senior citizen residents due to property transfer back to the Mendota Unified School District.

FISCAL IMPACT

ISSUE

Shall the City Council adopt Resolution No. 22-12, approving the City of Mendota's Local Road Safety Plan (LRSP) included in the Multijurisdictional Local Road Safety Plan (MLRSP) prepared by Fresno Council of Governments (FCOG)?

BACKGROUND

The Multijurisdictional Local Road Safety Plan (MLRSP) was initiated by FCOG and completed by their consultants Kittelson & Associates, Inc. (Kittelson) and Toole Design Group (TDG) to enable ten of the FCOG member agencies to prepare their first local road safety plans. The ten participating local jurisdictions are:

- City of Clovis
- City of Coalinga
- City of Firebaugh
- Fresno County (Unincorporated)
- City of Huron
- City of Kerman
- City of Mendota
- City of Orange Cove
- City of San Joaquin
- City of Selma

The focus of the MLRSP's development is to identify the following for each of the local jurisdictions:

- Crash patterns and trends
- Systemic engineering treatments to help reduce crash risk
- Education, enforcement, and/or emergency services strategies to help improve roadway safety
- High priority locations for projects with supporting design concepts
- Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) grant applications to facilitate securing funding for high priority safety projects

ANALYSIS

The MLRSP document presents an LRSP for each of the above local agencies, including the City of Mendota. The LRSPs were informed by technical analysis as well as input from key stakeholders and input from the general public. The introductory chapter of the MLRSP describes the process used to develop the plans, the types of strategies identified for each local agency, and FCOG's regional efforts to improve roadway safety.

The next ten chapters of the MLRSP then presents each local jurisdiction's LRSP. The City of Mendota's LRSP is included in Chapter 8.

FISCAL IMPACT

There is no direct fiscal impact of approval of this document. FCOG funded the preparation of the MLRSP. The Federal Highway Administration and Caltrans will now be requiring a municipality to have an approved LRSP in order to apply for funding through the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) starting with the upcoming cycle.

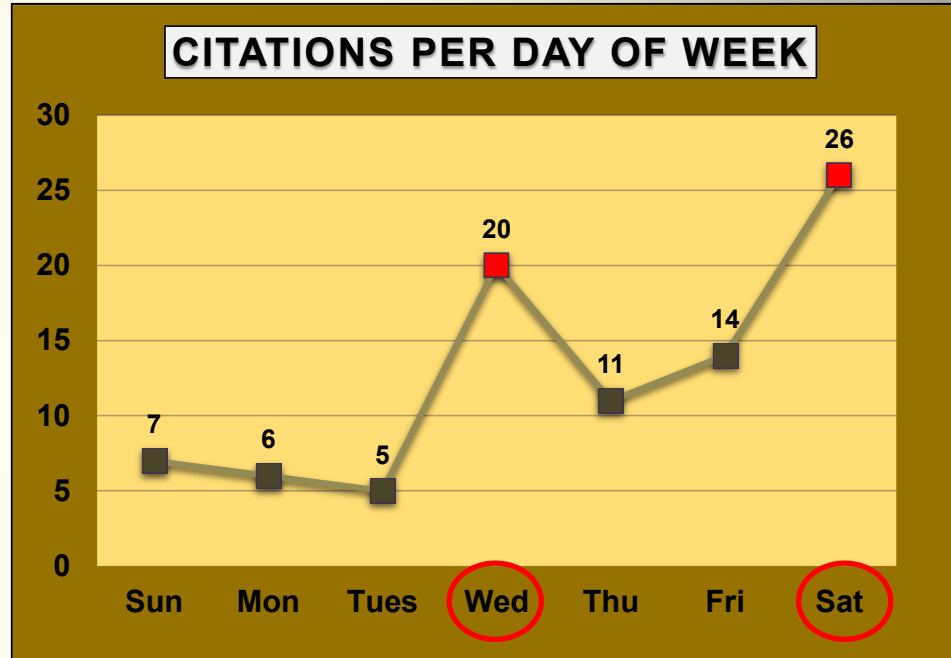

Mendota Police Dispatch Changes

On March 1, 2022, at 8:00 am, the City of Mendota and its Police Department will be contracting dispatch services with the Fresno Sheriff's Office to handle dispatch responsibilities.

For many years Mendota Police Department calls for service, including 911 calls, have been handled by a Dispatcher at the Firebaugh Police Department, but new leadership brought new ideas.

"I got here about six years ago and I had to take a hard look at all aspects of the operations of the police department. One of those was dispatch," said Mendota Police Chief Kevin W. Smith.

Questions have come up as to whether the Fresno Sheriff's Dispatch Center would be accepting low priority calls such as Code Enforcement violations and Animal Nuisance calls. The answer is absolutely, "YES." Chief Smith insists Mendota calls for service will not be lost in the shuffle. 911 calls in the city will automatically route to the Sheriff's Office.

Our office will remain OPEN to the public during business hours. Our direct line is still (559) 655-9120. After hours, our business line will be forwarded to the Fresno County Sheriff's Office. As of March 1, at 8:00, 2022, the afterhours non-emergency number is (559) 600-3111.

The Fresno County Sheriff's Office dispatches for other communities like Kerman, Kingsburg, Fowler, Orange Cove and Sanger.

What happens when you call 911?

When you call 911, your call is answered by an emergency call-taker whose first responsibility is to find out if this is a true emergency, is someone injured, is there a crime in progress, is there a fire, etc. If it is an emergency, the call-taker will handle your call. If the call-taker determines it is not an emergency, your call may be transferred to a non-emergency line.

The best and fastest way to get a response to your emergency is to patiently answer all the questions the call-taker asks you. We understand that it can be difficult to be patient when you're terrified, but if you can remain as calm as possible and answer questions clearly, things will go much faster. When seconds count, you don't want to waste any time repeating yourself, or screaming while the call-taker tries to calm you down.

It may seem that we are wasting time asking silly questions, but what you don't know is that units may already be enroute to your location. Dispatchers save the officers precious time at the scene by asking all these questions while they are enroute, then the information is relayed to them over their vehicle computers. Also, it may seem that we ask questions that are irrelevant or obvious, but we follow a set pattern of questions that have been proven to be important. At every call, the call-taker has a fill-in-the-blank screen on his/her computer that is followed. The screen includes the location of the incident, the name, address, and phone number of the reporting party, space for an explanation of the problem, and a space for the call type.

The call explanation is kept as brief as possible while relaying pertinent information that the officers will need to know. Common questions are where the responsible party is, or his/her direction of travel and how long ago he/she left; clothing descriptions of the responsible party, what weapons were involved, descriptions of vehicles involved, etc. The call-taker may also ask you for a clothing description of you or other victims or innocent bystanders at the scene. This is so that the officers know in advance that

you are the victim and not the responsible party!

Another crucial piece of information is the location of the incident. Even though we frequently have your address relayed to us over our Enhanced 911 screens, we always verify with you that the location is correct. Computers are not always correct, and the location of the incident may be behind your house, at a neighbor's house, or in a field without an exact address. We need to know that in order to send the units directly to the correct location.

If you called 911 by mistake, don't just hang up, tell the call-taker that you misdialed. All 911 hang-ups are called back, and if we cannot make contact with you again, we will dispatch an officer to the location showing in the Enhanced 911 screen. We do this because occasionally (for example in hostage situations or domestic violence cases) a victim tries to call for help but is interrupted, and his/her life is in danger unless they drop the phone and/or run and hide. However, do not call and hang up just to get a response because you know we will dispatch to you. Except in the cases just mentioned, you will get faster response if you stay on the phone to relay the pertinent information to us.
