MINUTES OF MENDOTA REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING

Regular Meeting

April 11, 2023

Meeting called to order by Mayor Martinez at 6:03 PM.

Roll Call

A motion was made by Council Member Riofrio to adopt the agenda, seconded by Council Member Alonso; unanimously approved (4 ayes, absent: Rosales).

CITIZENS ORAL AND WRITTEN PRESENTATIONS

Veronica Rasmussen-Gil – inquired about the possibility of the City assisting with a veterinary clinic event to spay and neuter dogs to help with the ongoing issue of stray dogs.

Discussion was held on the inquiry made by Ms. Rasmussen-Gil.

Phyliss – requested clarification on City and State laws pertaining to dirt bikes and inquired about the City providing a location where community members could ride their dirt bikes legally.

Discussion was held on the comments made by Phyliss.

Mayor Martinez introduced the item and Director of Administrative Services Lekumberry provided the report.

Discussion was held on the report provided by Director of Administrative Services Lekumberry.

Mayor Martinez opened the hearing to the public and seeing no one willing to comment closed the hearing to the public within the same minute.

A motion was made by Council Member Alonso to waive the second reading and adopt Ordinance No. 23-01, seconded by Council Member Riofrio; unanimously approved (4 ayes, absent: Rosales).

DEPARTMENT REPORTS AND INFORMATIONAL ITEMS

1. Finance Director
 - a) Grant Update

Finance Director Banda provided an update on various grants and programs; commented on the upcoming SB1383 Educational Workshop that will be held on April 21st at the AMOR Wellness Center, and on the Adelante Mendota movie night that will be held on April 21st at Rojas-Pierce Park.

Discussion was held on the information provided by Finance Director Banda.

2. City Engineer
 - a) Update

City Engineer Osborn provided an update on ongoing City projects, including the Rojas-Pierce Park Phase 2 Expansion Project, the Mendota Junior High School (“MJHS”) Safe Routes to School Project and the Mendota Stormwater Improvement Project.

3. City Attorney
 - a) Update

Assistant City Attorney Castro provided an update on ongoing projects; possible regulations to businesses licenses; and stated that he is ready to assist staff with anything they may need.

4. City Manager
 - a) Business licenses

City Manager Gonzalez provided an update on the business license process in the City, commented on the possibility of regulating certain businesses such as smoke shops; reported on an upcoming Advocacy Trip to Sacramento; on the upcoming Employee Recognition and Appreciation Lunch; the status of the Mendota Police Department/City Council Chambers Project; the inclusive playground at Rojas-Pierce Park; the Pool Park Rehabilitation Project and the upcoming Mendota Clean Up and Beautification Program.

Discussion was held on the report provided by City Manager Gonzalez.

MAYOR AND COUNCIL REPORTS AND INFORMATIONAL ITEMS

1. Council Member(s)

Council Member Alonso commented on the need for business owners to clean and maintain their properties; the City’s 2023 Earth Day Celebration Event; an upcoming Advocacy Trip to Sacramento and stated that he has been researching grants to improve the City’s dog pound facility.

Mayor Pro Tem Lopez commented on a cleanup event that will be held on Friday, April 14th; an event to provide resources to homeless individuals on April 15th; on the Department of Motorized Vehicles (“DMV”) expanding its facility in the City; on the Employee Recognition and Appreciation Lunch and stated that she is happy with the work of the City Council.

Discussion was held on the report provided by Mayor Pro Tem Lopez.

Council Member Riofrio thanked City staff for their work, commented on grant opportunities for the City; on the need to upgrade the dog pound facility; the MJHS Safe Routes to School Project, including the need to continue to improve crossings near schools; on smoke shops in the City and the possibility of regulating them; and on the City being stricter when it comes to tobacco and cannabis businesses/products.

Discussion was held on the report provided by Council Member Riofrio and on payments owed to the City by Odyssey Agricultural Development, LLC.

Mayor Pro Tem Lopez commented on a meeting with Self-Help staff; a meeting held with staff at Federal Correctional Institution, Mendota (“FCI Mendota”); on the possibility of prisoners at FCI Mendota assisting with dog training and on the need to address stray dogs in the City.

2. Mayor

Mayor Martinez commented on the upcoming Employee Recognition and Appreciation Lunch; on the need to address public drinking at different businesses in the City, on the need to address the homeless situation in the City; on the positive changes being seen throughout the City and thanked City staff for their work.

Discussion was held on the report provided by Mayor Martinez.

Dear Senator Caballero,

On behalf of the City of Mendota, I am pleased to offer our strong support for SB 524, which gives pharmacists authority to provide direct treatment for patients following certain positive test results.

The City of Mendota is a rural community that currently maintains a population of over 12,000 with a median household income of \$38,360 and a poverty rate of 37.5%, which is three times the poverty level of California of 12.3%. Oftentimes, many of our residents have to overcome many hurdles in order to access medical care and treatments they need due to financial restraints and the geographic location of our community. This is also true for other Californians who reside in rural communities as they are confronted by numerous obstacles such as a shortage of physicians and other providers, lack of transportation, hospital closures, and limited access to treatments for various viral illnesses. Many rural Californians may face expensive emergency room visits and long wait times in order to be treated for diseases like COVID-19 or the flu. Furthermore, the average drive time to a hospital in rural communities is often too far for patients in urgent need of care.

Millions of Californians benefit from receiving testing, vaccines and treatment from pharmacies. Recognizing the essential role of pharmacies in combatting the COVID-19 pandemic, the Department of Consumer Affairs (DCA) gave pharmacists the authority to prescribe a COVID-19 treatment, Paxlovid, directly to patients. When this authority expires, pharmacists' ability to independently provide treatment to patients will end.

SB 409 (Caballero, Chapter 604, 2021) gave pharmacists authority to perform several FDA-approved or authorized tests. This allows pharmacists to screen for COVID-19 and several other common illnesses. Pharmacists cannot currently prescribe treatment for many of these common health care conditions for which they are able to perform testing, which limits access to treatment for Californians.

SB 524 allows pharmacists to prescribe treatment for certain common conditions for which pharmacists can currently perform tests. These conditions include COVID-19, influenza, sexually transmitted infections, strep throat, and conjunctivitis. With nearly nine in 10 Californians living within five miles of a community pharmacy, the role of the pharmacist in orchestrating a patient's care is an underused resource. For many patients, community pharmacies are their primary access point for health care. Pharmacists are rigorously trained to provide treatments to patients. Getting

tested and treated directly by a pharmacy may often be the fastest way for an individual to get treatment and stop the spread of illness. This bill provides increased access and protects the health of thousands of Californians, especially in rural parts of the state.

For these reasons, SB 524 (Caballero) would further the City's goal of protecting the well-being of our residents by increasing access to healthcare and the medical resources they need to live fruitful and long-lasting lives. The Mendota community is proud to support SB 524 (Caballero) and encourage your "aye" vote when it is heard in your committee.

Dear Senator Caballero,

On behalf of the City of Mendota, I am pleased to offer our strong support for SB 621, which increases patient access to certain low-cost medications that are just as effective as brand-named drugs.

The City of Mendota has a population of over 12,000 with a median household income of \$38,360 and a poverty rate of 37.5%, which is three times the poverty level of California of 12.3%. Many of our residents depend on costly life-saving medications and oftentimes have no other choice than to pay significant out-of-pocket costs on brand-named drugs.


According to the Congressional Budget Office, per capita spending on prescription drugs increased by 700% between 1980 and 2018. Many patients pay tens of thousands of dollars annually in out-of-pocket costs for life-saving medications. The high cost of prescription drugs is in part due to the lack of competition that branded drug companies receive from lower-priced - but equally effective -treatment options.

Biosimilars are drugs that are rigorously tested and approved by the Food and Drug Administration ("FDA") as having "no clinically meaningful difference" from a brand-named drug in terms of safety, purity, and potency. This means that biosimilars are just as safe and effective as a brand named drug, while also being less expensive. For products with biosimilar competition, biosimilars have reduced costs between 18 and 50%. Despite biosimilars' widespread adoption in Europe, barriers to their adoption remain in the United States.

SB 621 (Caballero) would allow health plans to have the tools to directly access a lower-cost biosimilar before the equivalent brand drug. This bill also extends relevant patient protections to the usage of biosimilars, such as the ability of a provider to request that the original brand treatment be utilized. A prescriber in California will have to approve the use of a biosimilar prior to it being administered to a patient. Ultimately, SB 621 will give patients greater access to treatments for diseases such as arthritis and diabetes, by helping patients access lower-cost and equally effective alternatives to expensive brand-named prescription drugs.

For these reasons, SB 621 (Caballero) would further the City's goal of protecting the lives and well-being of our residents by ensuring that they have access to affordable life-saving medications and subsequently reducing the amount of financial stress and uncertainties that they face. The Mendota community is proud to support SB 621 (Caballero) when it is heard in the Senate Health Committee.

Dear Senator Caballero,

On behalf of the City of Mendota, I am pleased to offer our strong support for SB 870, which will leverage the Managed Care Organization (“MCO”) tax as a tool to help stabilize the healthcare system in the State of California.

The City of Mendota currently maintains a population of over 12,000 with a median household income of \$38,360 and a poverty rate of 37.5%, which is three times the poverty level of California of 12.3%. The majority of our residents are Medi-Cal enrollees who highly depend on rural community providers and hospitals for medical care. The City of Mendota strives to ensure that our residents have access to these critical resources as lack thereof will have detrimental consequences to our community.

The COVID-19 pandemic drained \$12 billion from hospitals, and skyrocketing prices for pharmaceuticals, staff, and medical supplies have put many hospitals on the brink of collapse. In January 2023, a rural community hospital in Madera closed its doors. Without immediate action, experts warn that dozens of hospitals across the state are at risk of closing or declaring bankruptcy. This would have serious consequences for patient care across the state. One recent study showed that hospital closures in rural areas resulted in a 9% increase in mortality rates for medical emergencies.

Furthermore, the hospitals most in danger of closing are small hospitals that service a high proportion of Medi-Cal patients. These hospitals are at most risk of collapse due to the low rates of Medi-Cal reimbursements. For every dollar that it costs to care for Medi-Cal patients, California pays only 74 cents. California’s low Medi-Cal reimbursement rates for physicians and other providers—48th in the nation—mean that these small hospitals have trouble recruiting doctors and nurses as well.


Most Medi-Cal enrollees are low-income people of color. The low rate of Medi-Cal reimbursement has resulted in a two-tiered healthcare system, where the hospitals serving communities who need healthcare most are at the greatest risk of collapse.

California's tax on Managed Care Organizations (MCOs) has served, in the past, as an engine for state financing. It has historically generated enough revenue to ensure that Medi-Cal reimbursements are the same or higher and produced an additional ~1.5 billion dollars each year for investment in a variety of state programs. In December 2022, the MCO Tax expired, stripping California of an integral mechanism for financing many important state programs.

SB 870 would renew the Managed Care Organization tax to leverage access to federal funds to make resources available to invest in healthcare solutions. It could serve as a tool for higher Medi-Cal reimbursement rates, which benefits hospitals, doctors, and other providers across the state. It could also help increase the number of doctors, nurses, and other health care professionals by investing in scholarship and tuition reimbursement for practicing or working in economically disadvantaged communities. The MCO tax will increase access to healthcare for low-income communities of color, and provide a long-term solution to prevent the collapse of dozens of small hospitals throughout California.

For these reasons, SB 870 (Caballero) would further the City's goal of protecting the well-being of our residents by ensuring that they have access to healthcare and the medical resources they need to live fruitful and long-lasting lives. The Mendota community is proud to support SB 870 (Caballero) and encourage your "aye" vote when it is heard in your committee.

Dear Senator Wiener:

Housing is one of the top issues facing older adults. This is evidenced by the growing number of older adults experiencing homelessness across California. In fact, individuals 50 and over make up approximately half of the state's single adult homeless population. SB 17 (Caballero) will help provide critical affordable housing for older adults. We write to you in strong SUPPORT of SB 17.

Housing Costs Have Outpaced Fixed Incomes

Rising housing costs affect all Californians, but no group has been harmed more than low-income older adults, whose incomes have increased less than those of any other age cohort. Many low-income older adults only income is fixed retirement incomes, such as Social Security and Supplemental Security Income (SSI). According to a report published by the National Institute on Retirement Security, based on data collected in the Census Bureau's 2014 Survey of Income Program Participation, the plurality, 40% percent of older adults only source of retirement income is Social Security.

In California, over 570,000 older adults rely on SSI. In 2023, the maximum SSI/SSP benefit for a single older adult living independently is \$1,133.73. According to the National Low-Income Housing Coalition, the average Fair Market Rent for a studio apartment in California is \$1,416. This means hundreds of thousands of older adults cannot afford rent in California even if they spend their entire monthly income on it. In 26 out of 58 California counties, the HUD determined Fair Market Rent (FMR) for a 1-bedroom apartment exceeds the state's maximum SSI payment for older adults.

Drastic Rise in Homelessness

As incomes for older adults have fallen further and further behind, older adults are constituting a rapidly increasing share of the state's homeless population. According to the California Bureau of Business, Consumer, and Housing Services' (BCHS) Homelessness Data Integration Services Dashboard (HDIS), the number of Californians 55 and older accessing homelessness services increased by 84% between 2017 and 2021, nearly double the rate of increase of the general population. The increase for Californians over 65 is even more stark: between 2017 and 2021, the number of Californians over 65 accessing homelessness services increased by 140%.

Among those 50 and over experiencing homelessness, nearly half became homeless for the first time after age 50. Without action, the housing and homelessness crisis among older adults will only worsen. In addition to the widening disparity between fixed incomes and housing costs, older adults are constituting an increasingly large share of the state's population. By 2030, 25% of the state's population – an estimated 10.8 million people – will be age 60 or older. The population over age 60 is

expected to increase 166% between 2010 and 2060. In that same period, the population over age 85 is expected to increase 489%.

Rental housing is a popular housing option for older people who seek more accessibility and less maintenance. However, while there are over 200,000 older adults in affordable rental housing in California, almost two-thirds of senior households who qualify for affordable housing don't receive it, because there is just not enough supply.

Senior affordable housing is a critical part of our long-term care continuum

Senior affordable housing is a critical component of California's long-term care continuum. These communities benefit from economies of scale, having large groups of older adults living in one location. This makes affordable senior housing communities an effective and cost-efficient locus for providing care and services to residents that help create housing stability, maintain independent living through improved health outcomes, and avoid premature or preventable transfer to institutional care settings such as hospitals and skilled nursing facilities.

A recent study of nearly 9,000 affordable senior housing residents across the United States found the older adults living in affordable housing communities with onsite service coordinators (which most senior affordable housing communities in California have) were 18% less like to be admitted to hospital emergency departments than those living in communities without service coordinators. And various other studies have shown lower Medicare expenditures, higher utilization of preventative care, success reaching vulnerable populations, and fewer nursing home transfers because of increased services for older adults in affordable housing.

Over the past few years, California has taken great strides to solve the state's housing issues. It is important to remember that older adults have a special set of housing needs that the Legislature must consider when drafting housing policy to guarantee that no one is left behind as new housing programs are created.

Senate Bill 17 seeks to ensure that older adults receive a fair share of funding from the state's Low Income Housing Tax Credit Program (LIHTC). LIHTC is a housing financing program administered by the Tax Credit Allocation Committee (TCAC) of the State Treasury for the purpose of assisting the new construction, rehabilitation, and preservation of affordable rental housing.

Under the Qualified Allocation Plan, TCAC allocates a percentage of LIHTC funding toward affordable senior housing developments. This is known as the "Senior Goal." However, the Goal requires only 15 percent of credits to go to projects primarily benefiting older adults. This Goal does not reflect the current demographics of our low-income renter population and will only put older adults further behind as California ages.

SB 17 will modernize the older adult goal within LIHTC by requiring TCAC to use American Community Survey data, released annually by the U.S. Census Bureau, to determine the minimum amount of the senior allocation. This will make the number of affordable senior housing units built with LIHTC more reflective of the actual housing needs of our older adults.

Thank you for your leadership on this issue.

RE: AB 412 (Soria) — Hospital Emergency Loan Program — SUPPORT

Dear Assemblymember Wood:

As the Mayor of the City of Mendota, I write in strong support of AB 412, which seeks to establish the Hospital Emergency Loan Program. This bill authorizes the State Treasurer's Office to provide emergency loans through the California Health Facilities Financing Authority ("CHFFA"), for qualifying hospitals to prevent their closure or to assist with the reopening of a recently closed hospital.

As an ongoing effect of the COVID-19 pandemic, many small and rural hospitals are struggling to operate on diminished margins. A decrease in elective procedures combined with increased operating costs led to a decrease in hospital operating margins across the western United States by 69 percent since 2019, with 2022 having been the worst year of that period.

The closure of Madera Community Hospital ("MCH"), the lone general acute care hospital in the County of Madera, left tens of thousands of low-income residents with no other option than to travel nearly an hour to the nearest hospital in order to seek treatment. Hospitals in the neighboring counties of Fresno and Merced are inundated with the increased surge of patients seeking care.

With consideration of the state budget, this bill creates a dedicated program within the CHFFA to help financially distressed hospitals, which will include strong accountability measures to ensure that any hospitals receiving loans from the program must develop a plan to regain financial viability and ultimately pay back the amount due.

For these reasons the City of Mendota strongly supports AB 412.

DATE: APRIL 25, 2023

ISSUE

Shall the City Council adopt Resolution No. 23-24, authorizing the addition of two regular full-time entry level police officer positions for the Mendota Police Department?

BACKGROUND

The City of Mendota (“City”) Police Department (the “Department”) is currently authorized a total of 19 sworn officer positions. Out of these 19 positions, only 7 positions are regular (with benefits) full-time police officers. For a breakdown of the sworn officer positions please see the following chart:

*These positions (**in bold**) are full-time positions with benefits outlined in their respective MOU or benefit resolution

**These are full-time positions with no benefits (other than the same offered to part-time employees)

Currently, out of the 13 regular full-time positions (with benefits) there are two (2) Regular Police Officer vacancies and two (2) contract Police Officer Vacancies. The two vacancies for the contract police officer positions are in preparation for the two (2) SRO positions the school will be adding in August. After the SRO program expands, the City will revert to the four (4) Contract Police Officer positions. It is important to note that out of the seven (7) Regular Police Officer positions, three (3) of those officers currently serve strictly as School Resource Officers (“SRO(s)”) for the Mendota Unified School District (“MUSD”). Out of the three SROs two are paid 100% by MUSD and MUSD pays 75% of the remaining officer. The SROs must be dedicated full-time to their designated school sites and may only assist with City duties on emergency cases.

Currently, the City employs ten (10) fully benefitted regular sworn officer positions (not including the SROs), however two (2) of those are administrative positions and four (4) of those are supervisor positions. To be clear, once all of the current vacancies are filled and the reduction from six (6) to four (4) Contract Police Officer positions occurs, there will be twelve (12) officers to provide patrol and other law enforcement services to the City.

In general, the larger cities have a greater presence of police officers than smaller and mid-sized jurisdictions. As a general rule in California, it is recommended that we employ at least 1 Police Officer per 1,000 residents. The latest U.S. Census estimated that the City's population is almost 13,000 residents. Moreover, it is believed that the City jumps in population to about 25,000 residents during the summer months due to our robust agricultural industry. Following the general rule in California, the Mendota Police Department should have a minimum of 13 police officers, however realistically speaking it should have at least 14 positions to account for the underreported population in the City of Mendota.

ANALYSIS

The Mendota Police Department, along with many other law enforcement agencies across the nation are struggling to fill vacancies. Other agencies have addressed this obstacle by enhancing the benefits, pay, and even by offering sign-on bonuses. While the City of Mendota is unable to offer sign on bonuses at this time, it can address the recruitment challenges by recruiting for positions that have benefits. This alone is a step forward in being able to draw interest from individuals to work with the Mendota Police Department. At this time, the Department is experiencing a high level of vacancies with four (4) police officer positions remaining unfilled, and only two of those positions being fully benefitted positions .

Over the past several years, the City has experienced a significant increase in its population and the Department has experienced an increase in demands, duties, and the programs that it oversees and executes. The Department continues to remain dedicated and committed to providing the citizens of Mendota with the best possible public safety services. However, over the past several years, it has become exceedingly difficult for the Department to meet the increased demand for public safety services, due to the lack of growth in the Department's personnel. It has slowly become evident that the Department's efficiency and effectiveness is struggling as it is attempting to do more with minimal staffing that is resulting in employee burn out, stress, and morale issues which is contributing to the ever-revolving door that the Department is facing in terms of staffing.

In strategizing a potential solution to be able to effectively meet and exceed the community's needs as well as to address the employee burn out, stress, and morale issues, it was identified that there is a need for additional sworn officer positions. The Department will greatly benefit from the addition of two additional Regular Police Officer positions (with benefits), so that it may effectively address the community's demands but also provide the Department with the capacity it needs to meet additional service needs. The Department currently does not have a Detective position which creates a struggle to provide the level of quality service in police investigations. The Department is also unable to effectively investigate criminal gang activity since it cannot assign a police officer to serve as a gang enforcement liaison. These investigations require undercover officers and networking with the Fresno County Sheriff's Department's MAGEC Task Force, to be effective.

In 2022, the sergeants and officers collectively worked a total of 3,488.25 hours of overtime costing the City \$133,942.60. Two additional full time police officers would result in approximately 4,368 hours of coverage minus vacation and/or sick leave utilized. This would

reduce the mandatory overtime hours that our current staff are working, therefore reducing burnout, stress, and low morale. The Department is optimistic that the creation of these fully benefitted police officer positions, will allow the Department to be viewed as a desired agency to work for like some of the other law enforcement agencies. Police officer positions that do not have benefits (such as the City's Contract Police Officer positions) are not enticing to potential recruits and often results in the City losing valuable personnel and recruits to larger agencies. It is also notable that if the City Council elects to move forward with adding the two additional regular full-time entry level police officer positions, it will be at least a minimum of six (6) months before the officers become solo beat officers due to the lengthy hiring and training process, which is required by the Peace Officer's Standards of Training (POST.)

FISCAL IMPACT

In 2022, the sergeants and officers collectively worked a total of 3488.25 hours of overtime costing the City \$133,942.60. The total cost of adding the two new police officer positions consists of the costs of the salary and benefits, which is estimated to be in the amount of \$55,587.74 plus benefits for the first year per officer (\$111,175.48 plus benefits for both positions). These two positions would cover 2,184 hours each for a total of 4,368 hours of coverage, which would cover and exceed the hours that were worked in overtime alone in 2022. This expenditure was not previously authorized in the City's budget, but it has been determined that funding is available to be allocated for the costs out of the General Fund. It is crucial that these positions be authorized at this time due to the length of time that it takes for a recruit to become a solo beat officer.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the City Council adopt Resolution No. 23-24, authorizing the addition of two new regular full-time entry level police officer positions for the Mendota Police Department.

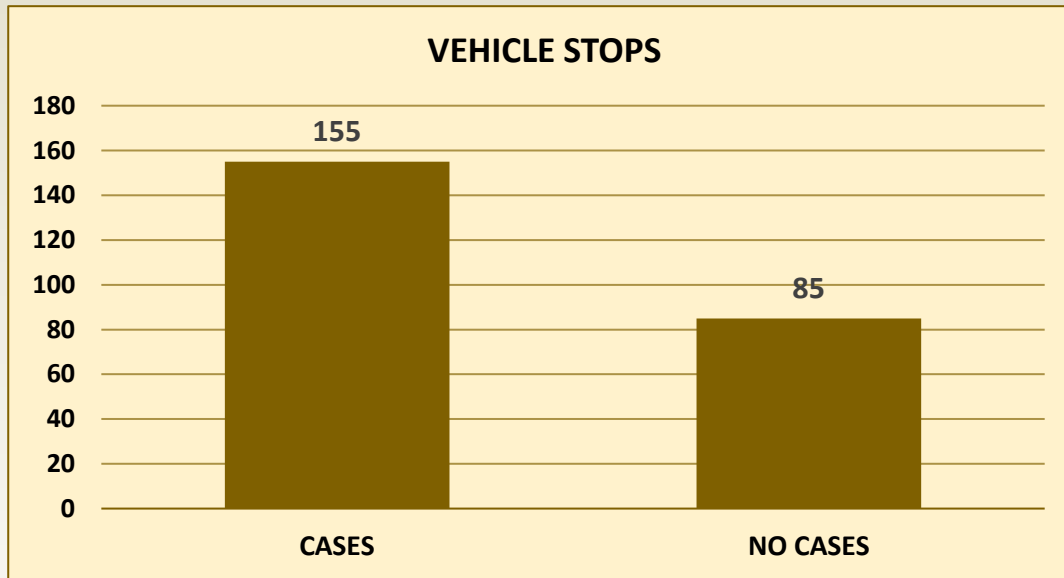
