A City of Mendota ("City") Entertainment Encroachment Permit ("Permit") is required to encroach on public right-of-way for any period of time. The cost for a Permit is \$75.00 (unless otherwise noted). An application for a Permit must be submitted no later than 5 business days prior to the scheduled event date. Applicants are required to provide all necessary equipment to mark the encroached area, unless otherwise coordinated. The Mendota Police Department and Public Works Department may impose additional conditions of approval. If the proposed right-of-way encroachment includes any portion of State Highways (Highways 33 or 180), the applicant is required to obtain additional permits and documents from the California Department of Transportation ("Caltrans"). Failure to obtain any and all necessary permits and documents from Caltrans will delay the processing of the City's Permit application or result in the denial thereof.

No person, shall possess, have, or be in control of any open container of beer, wine or other intoxicating or alcoholic beverage on or within any street, sidewalk, alley, highway, playground, park or in any vacant or public parking lot within the city, unless otherwise stated in this chapter. MMC Section 9.22.050 – Violation – Misdemeanor.  Any person or entity violating any of the provisions of this chapter shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine in a sum not exceeding one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) or by imprisonment in the country jail for a period not exceeding six months or by both such fine and imprisonment.


