#### FINALIZE THE AGENDA

1. Adoption of final Agenda.

A motion was made by Commissioner Quintanar to adopt the agenda, seconded by Vice-Chair Nolan; unanimously approved (3 ayes).

## **SWEARING OF NEW COMMISSIONERS**

1. Swearing In of Planning Commissioners Albert Escobedo and Martin Gamez.

Planning and Economic Development Manager Flood administered the oath of office to Commissioners Escobedo and Gamez.

#### NOTICE OF WAIVING READING

1. Approval of the Minutes of the Regular Meeting of June 17, 2014.

A motion to approve item 1 was made by Commissioner Quintanar, seconded by Commissioner Escobedo; unanimously approved (5 ayes).

2. Notice of waiving the reading of all resolutions introduced and/or adopted under this agenda.

A motion to approve item 2 was made by Commissioner Quintanar, seconded by Vice-Chair Nolan; unanimously approved (5 ayes).

#### **PUBLIC HEARING**

1. Public Hearing to adopt **Resolution No. PC 15-01**, forwarding a recommendation to the City Council to approve Application No. 14-09, consisting of Tentative Parcel Map No. 14-01 and a Mitigated Negative Declaration.

Chairperson Garcia introduced the item and City Planner O'Neal provided a summary of the Draft I.S. and M.N.D.; certain regulatory statutes; the impacts of an onsite storm water basin; and parcel storm drain usage.

Discussion was held on the different parcels and various zoning designations.

At 7:00 p.m. Chairperson Garcia opened the hearing to the public.

**Leo Capuchino (390 K Street)**- stated that there was severe flooding on Belmont and Derrick avenues back in the 1980's; regulations were implemented during that time; and asked if the berm at the location had been cleared.

Discussion was held regarding potential flooding issues; a berm not existing on Belmont Avenue; sidewalk and driveway formation; businesses that are interested in taking up the parcels; the amount of parking space; and the owner of the property.

At 7:15 p.m. seeing that there was not anyone else wishing to comment, Chairperson Garcia closed the hearing to the public.

A motion was made by Commissioner Quintanar to approve PC Resolution No. 15-01, seconded by Vice-Chairperson Nolan; unanimously approved (5 ayes).
