## ISSUE

Shall the Recreation Commission approve the exclusive use permit for the use of the Benny Mares Sr. Baseball Field for a youth tournament to be held on July 8th and 9th?

## BACKGROUND

Westside Youth Center, Inc. (WYC) has requested the use of the Benny Mares Sr. Baseball Field for two days, July 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup>, for a youth tournament.

The tournament will be for youth up to 12 years old and will have the same number of games that they have been having.

### ANALYSIS

This request is routine and consistent with the intended use of the baseball field. Staff would ask that the Commission approve the use and impose the usual conditions of approval for our local non-profit organizations: payment of the fees for use of the concession stand (a total of \$80), that WYC maintain the field based on their use and immediately report any observed problems, whether or not caused directly by their use, to the Director of Public Works or his designee, and a \$250 security deposit to be returned once the event is over and verification has been made as to the condition of the facilities.

## FISCAL IMPACT

Slight revenue from the usage fees of the concession stand. Cost of normal wear and tear on the field caused by such use.

## RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends the Commission approve the use of the Benny Mares Sr. Baseball Field by WYC for the dates requested in the application with the abovementioned conditions.
