MINUTES OF MENDOTA REGULAR RECREATION COMMISSION MEETING

Regular Meeting Thursday, August 2, 2018

Meeting called to order by Chairperson Robert Silva at 12:01 p.m.

A motion was made by Commissioner Sanchez to adopt the agenda, seconded by Commissioner Gonzalez; unanimously approved (4 ayes, absent: Luna and Ochoa).

A motion was made by Commissioner Sanchez to approve items 1 and 2, seconded by Commissioner Gonzalez; unanimously approved (4 ayes, absent: Luna and Ochoa).

BUSINESS

1. Commission discussion on an adult softball tournament organized and managed by a separate organization.

Chairperson Silva reported that he was approached by individuals who are interested in using the baseball field for a softball league; that such requests need to come before the Recreation Commission for consideration and approval; and introduced Mr. Antonio Gonzales.

Antonio Gonzales – stated that there are several individuals that are interested in using the field for a softball league in the fall, and requested information on the process to request the use of the field.

Discussion was held on the possibility of Mendota Youth Recreation assisting the group in organizing the softball league.

Economic Development Manager Flood reported on the renovation of the baseball field in 2013; that the Recreation Commission was initially created to maintain the integrity of the field as well as manage the use of the field; the requirements that need to be fulfilled and the process that needs to be followed to request the use of the field; that the field was initially created for the use by children but that the field has been used by adults; and a softball league that was planned and organized a few years ago but did not come to fruition due to the lack of interest.

Discussion was held on how the City can support the league; the members of the league abiding by the rules; the insurance requirement; and the benefits of having a local non-profit organization acting like an umbrella organization for the league.

The Commission directed staff to work with Mr. Gonzales on the proposed fall softball league.

COMMISSIONER REPORTS AND INFORMATIONAL ITEMS

Chairperson Silva reminded everyone about the upcoming Annual Gutierrez Family Backpack Giveaway event and invited the Commissioners to volunteer at the event.

Deputy City Clerk Cabrera reported that there is a vacancy on the Recreation Commission and that anyone that is interested in applying can pick up an application at City Hall.

ADJOURNMENT

At the hour of 12:58 p.m., with no more business to be brought before the Commission, a motion for adjournment was made by Commissioner Sanchez, with a second by Commissioner Barron; unanimously approved (4 ayes, absent: Luna and Ochoa).

SUBJECT: APPLICATION FOR USE OF THE BASEBALL FIELD BY MENDOTA YOUTH

RECREATION FOR AN ADULT SOFTBALL TOURNAMENT

DATE: SEPTEMBER 6, 2018

ISSUE

Shall the Recreation Commission approve the exclusive use permit for the use of the Benny Mares, Sr. Baseball Field for an adult tournament?

BACKGROUND

Mendota Youth Recreation (MYR) has requested the use of the Benny Mares Sr. Baseball Field to hold an adult softball tournament every Monday from September 21st until November 2nd, which would be a maximum total of 6 game days. The games would be from 5pm until 9pm, and would require the use of the lights.

The stated purpose of the tournament (application attached) is to be a fundraiser for "Girls Basketball".

ANALYSIS

Due to the expenses incurred in the renovation of the Benny Mares, Sr. Baseball Field, the City Council and Recreation Commission have stated that the intention is to give priority to youth organizations, both in order to support the youth and to preserve the physical integrity of the field. Therefore it is up to the Commission to discuss whether it thinks this use is appropriate.

As past practice when use of the field by adults is concerned, staff will not provide a recommendation as to whether to approve or deny the request, leaving that up to the Commission. However staff does recommend that, if the Commission is considering approving this use, measures be applied to ensure the integrity of the field, such as what type of footwear is permitted by participants.

Additionally, and due to the fact that this is not a non-profit use by youth, Staff is recommending that MYR pay the associated resident fees (attached) before the field is used:

- \$25 per half-day for use of the field (total based on request would be \$150)
- \$100 refundable cleaning deposit
- \$250 refundable administrative security deposit
- \$20 per hour use of lights (total based on request would be \$240)
- \$25 per half-day for use of the concession stand (if requested)

FISCAL IMPACT

Revenue from the usage fees to the general fund. Expenses related to the cost of wear and tear on the field caused by adult use.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends the Commission discuss the use of the field by MYR for a co-ed adult softball league.
